Ticketed Jumping Rounds

Tickets can be bought in advance or at the office and in-gate on show day.

- Tickets are \$20 each. See schedule for heights/times.
- All clear rounds will be awarded a blue ribbon.
- There is no limit to the amount of ticketed rounds one can do in each class. Ticket must be given at the in-gate before rider enters the ring.

HUNTER/EQUITATION DIVISIONS

Classes to be judged on rider's position, pace, and control of the horse. Proper show turnout rewarded. **Entry fee: \$35 per class. Championship and Reserve Championship** will be awarded in each division. Equitation class score will be used break any ties.

Walk Division

Judged at the walk only.

JUMPER DIVISIONS

First class in each height division will be Optimum Time. Second class in each height division will be a Speed class. **Champion and Reserve Champion** will be awarded in each division. In the event of a tie, time in the speed class will be used as the tie-breaker.

SPECIALTY CLASSES

410. \$1,000 Jumps West Invitational Jumper Classic 1.00m Entry Fee \$50

To be held Saturday night, August 17, at the JK Presents Summer Invitational Horse Show. *Entry fee will be waived for riders with invitations. Invitations will be mailed separately and are only valid for one horse and rider combination. Name on invitation must match rider name on entry to be valid. Winner to take the full \$1,000 prize money.

510. Costume Class

To be held Saturday, September 27 at the JK Presents Fall Festival Horse Show. Open to all horses and riders.

GAMES

310. Horse & Hound Relay – a TEAM EVENT

Each relay team consists of one horse, one rider, one holder and one dog. Relay goes as follows:

- Rider rides horse across ring and back again
- Rider dismounts, hand horse to Holder
- Holder gives dog to Rider (dog must be on leash)
- Rider will run the dog around a course of small jumps then to the finish line

Fastest time wins the class!

311. Pony / Horse Jumper Challenge – a TEAM EVENT

Teams consist of one horse / rider and one pony / rider combination. Pony jumps a 2' course, horse jumps a 3' course. Fastest combined time wins!

312. Judge's Command Class

Open to all riders. To be shown on the flat only. Judge will begin with simple commands that slowly increase in difficulty. Riders remain in play as long as they continue to execute commands correctly. When a rider makes a mistake, they are eliminated and will be called to the middle. Last horse and rider on the rail wins.

313. Bareback Challenge

Open to all riders. Riders may be asked to perform on the flat and over fences. Saddles and bareback pads not permitted. Class begins on the flat. Top riders after flat phase will continue to test over fences. Class will be judged on position, balance and control.

314. Family Challenge – a TEAM EVENT

Opens to teams of 2 people who must be related. Riders are stationed at opposite ends of arena. Rider #1 rides as fast as they can to Rider #2. Rider #1 dismounts, assists Rider #2 in mounting, and then leads Rider#2 back to the starting line. Fastest time wins.

315. Egg & Spoon

Open to all riders. To be shown on the flat only. Riders will be provided with egg and spoon, which can be held in either hand. Judge will call out commands; last rider with egg in the spoon wins.

316. Gambler's Choice

Each jump in the course is assigned a point value – easier fences have lower point values, difficult fences have higher point values. Rider strives to jump as many jumps and accumulate as many points as possible within the time allowed. There is no set order to jump. It is not necessary to jump all the jumps, however, no individual jump may be jumped more than three times. A rail down or refusal results in points for that fence being subtracted from the rider's tally. At the end of the time allowed, rider may elect to jump the special "Gambler's Jump" which is worth 50 points. No penalty is given for choosing not to jump the Gambler's fence, but if the rider attempts the jump and a rail down or refusal occurs, the 50 points will be subtracted from the rider's tally. The horse and rider with most points wins.

317. Ribbon Race – a TEAM EVENT

Open to all riders. A team consists of 2 horses and 2 riders. Each team is given a ribbon of toilet paper of equal length/sheets. Each rider holds one end of the tissue ribbon and while riding side by side execute commands as directed by announcer. Commands may include walk, trot, canter, halt, turn right, turn left. If the team's tissue ribbon breaks, they are eliminated. Teams may periodically be asked to stop and shorten their tissue ribbon length to make it more challenging! Last team with an unbroken ribbon of tissue wins.

Additional Information

We understand that running two arenas simultaneously presents the potential for class conflicts. We would appreciate it if the riders who share horses would keep this in mind when planning their class schedules. We will try to be as accommodating as possible, while keeping in mind the needs of the other competitors and the judges. Therefore we may not hold a class for more than 5 minutes. If you are unable to compete in a class because of a conflict, the secretary will refund your class fee.

The *Rules*

Please enter classes that are appropriate for the rider's and horse's levels of experience.

- ASTM - rated hard hats must be worn by all riders whenever mounted anywhere at the Horse Park
- No martingales permitted in hack or flat classes
- Stallions may not be shown by juniors
- All dogs must be leashed
- NO open fires, smoking or BBQing at the Horse Park
- USEF rules apply*
- All riders must complete an entry form and sign a release

Entry Fees

- \$30..... Per Dressage Test
- \$35..... Per Jumping Class
- \$20..... Ticketed Rounds
(ticketed rounds may be purchased in advance or on show day)

- \$20..... Office Fee
- \$15..... Grounds Fee
(Grounds fee must be paid for all horses that do reside at the Horse Park)
- \$5..... Drug Fee, per horse entered
- \$35..... Day stall
- \$50..... Overnight or weekend stabling
- \$10.50/bag..... Shavings

Refunds

After close of entries, refunds will be given only upon presentation of a Veterinarian's or Doctor's certificate.

No refunds will be given after the show begins.
