

# A UNIQUE, INTENSIVE EXPERIENCE...



For a few weeks each year, Frank and Dawn Casey open their home and ranch to small groups of riders. Here, they have the unique opportunity to participate in an intense, structured riding program while experiencing a true ranch lifestyle.

Casey Ranch is a working horse and cattle operation located on 365 rolling acres in Stratford, OK. With 11 stocked ponds, abundant wildlife and hours of riding trails, it offers a unique opportunity for competition riders to engage in “out of the ring” riding while under strict supervision.



## Ranch Living, Horse Care, Barn Management and “Out of the Ring” Lessons

**Casey Ranch Boot Camp is a 3-day overnight program limited to 4 riders per session.**

Riders bring their own horses and participate in riding lessons, barn management, trail riding, jump building, fishing, cooking and table setting. The nearby Air Donkey Zipline in Davis, OK ([www.airdonkeyzipline.com](http://www.airdonkeyzipline.com)) is also available for groups desiring a more adventurous afternoon between lessons and dinner.

**Participants must have intermediate riding and horsemanship skills and possess an intense desire to learn all aspects of riding, horse and barn management.** This program is based on classical riding principles emphasizing work on rider position, timing, and application of aids. It is meant to complement the work of your existing trainer by enhancing your current riding and horsemanship skills and encourage independent thinking and problem solving. Riders have daily lessons in the sand arena with full jump course or in the Derby field. The program is managed and directed by Dawn Casey, a USEF and AQHA Registered Judge, and Hunter Jumper trainer of 35+ years.

**Each horse is to arrive with all feed, hay, fans and all horse/rider equipment for the 3 day stay.** Horses are stalled in 16 x 18 stalls with rubber mats and enjoy nightly paddock turnout. Additional bedding is available at \$7.00 per bag. Riders are to wear boots, breeches and polo shirts for their lessons. They will be doing their own daycare as part of the barn management program and will also require appropriate “work” attire.

Participants may choose accommodations in the guest rooms at the main house or in the guest house near the barn.
